Approval Of the minutes: Kathrin Harris made a motion that the minutes as circulated be approved for May. Steve LaBossiere seconded the motion. John Smith asked to amend the minutes as follows under New Business: "Troopmaster.net, costing \$19.95/month, has been approved indefinitely." The minutes, as amended by above correction, were approved by all.

Call for Committee Reports (submit written reports to secretary)

Scoutmaster – Mike Acosta reported on Woodruff summer camp. It was a fun week and all agreed they would like to go again next year (Jun 15-21, 2008). An unfortunate thing occurred during the course of the week: sapling trees were cut down or destroyed. All 26 campers are held equally responsible, those not instigating or participating knew of the events and did not inform adults. Restitution will be that a conservation project be done soon here in Sarasota, where all 26 scouts from camp give service time (not counting toward advancement), and something also at Woodruff next year.

Treasurer – Steve LaBossiere reported that there is \$5046.73 available less personal accounts, and check #169 in the amount of \$252 to the Atlanta Council for 2008 summer camp deposit and ice at camp in 2007. Steve asked that the five drivers to Woodruff please submit their gas receipts ASAP. Several scouts have written letters asking their personal accounts be charged for either dues or summer camp costs. John Smith said his son Chris is turning 18 soon and wishes to donate his personal account balance to the troop. Another donation is a total payment of \$130 toward camp (not used) by the Stolz family to be used in future if someone needs help financing summer camp.

Liaison – none

Advancements – Mike Acosta will get us on troopmaster.net and Carrie Bon can post the advancements. Regarding accomplishments at summer camp, Mike will generate a report on each camper for partial merit badges. A PDF file can then be generated and sent to each scout. 12 scouts completed the Mountain man program. The achievements can be signed off at the next meeting in each scout's book by John Smith and other assistant scout masters. A Board of Review will also be held next week by request of a scout. Two Bronze palm awards (from January) are still due from council.
